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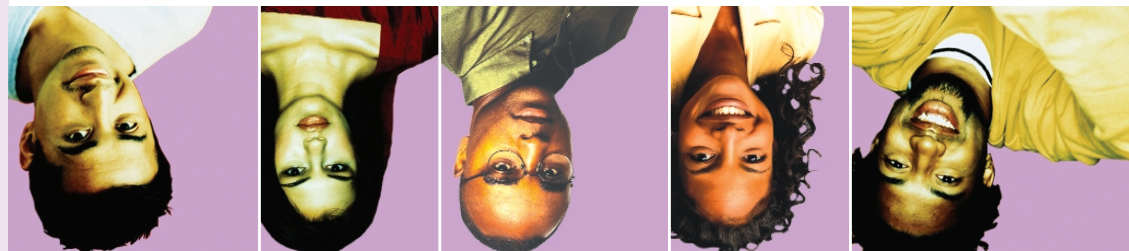

The Project also offers workshops and talks for community groups, schools, colleges, careers advisers and so on, about the need for more Black and Minority ethnic teachers.
